



Marine Service Technician / Marine Mechanic

Summary

This position carries out repairs on both power and sail vessels, including modifications, re-furbishing and upgrading; performs mechanical repairs on steering, propulsion, cooling and engine systems; troubleshoots and assesses electrical vessel components, modifies and / or installs plumbing systems

Duties and Responsibilities

- Inspect boats and decide on the type of work that needs to be done and provide an accurate estimate on time and materials required
- Review work orders/time lines with the service manager and other management to ensure projects are completed in a time required
- Compile parts lists for the completion of the work
- Order parts or provide appropriate staff member with all information (part numbers, brand name, pictures time frame required etc.) required to complete a project.
- Work efficiently and professionally to meet deadlines and performance goals while maintaining a positive attitude
- Repairs and maintains boats and similar vessels in marine service facility: Examines repair or installation orders, drawings, and vessel, utilizing knowledge based on past experience to determine extent of repairs required or modifications necessary for installation of equipment, accessories, and hardware.
- Consults with supervisor regarding installation or repair problems, sequence of operations, and time required to complete repair or installation.
- Coordinates with Yard Manager or other staff for the movement of vessels required for repairs.
- Tests engine, transmission, rigging, propeller, navigational, and related systems to diagnose malfunctions, using various measuring instruments.
- Installs and tests steering gear, sanitation and refrigeration systems, electrical systems and accessories, hardware, trim, and related components, following manufacturer's instructions and drawings.
- Work with management to quote work and the project management of installations such as engines/outboards.
- Assist with maintenance of Marina Yard Equipment as needed. Coordinate with Yard Manager for those repairs and maintenance.

Key Knowledge, Skills, Abilities and Behavioral Characteristics Needed

1. Maintain a service oriented, positive and respectful attitude towards management, staff and clients
2. Must be honest, dependable and forthright, with the ability to confidently work without direct supervision
3. Maintain a service oriented and positive, respectful attitude towards SWMS clients and other staff members
4. Maintain knowledge, understanding and comply with all SWMS Policies, Rules and applicable Occupational Health and Safety legislation
5. Operate SWMS vehicles, vessels and equipment in a competent, professional and safe manner

Job requirements

1. Meet Hourly/Revenue Expectations as determined on a quarterly basis and adhere to cost saving measures.
2. Knowledge of Marina Operations and safety techniques
3. Marine Service Technician Certificate or minimum of 5 years experience



4. Current First Aid and WHMIS certification
5. Strong troubleshooting skills
6. Forklift Operators Certificate – an asset but not required
7. Must be able to work indoors and outdoors in all weather conditions
8. Regularly work in small or tight spaces
9. Ability to work on the water
