

Octopus Craft

Materials:

- a toilet paper roll
- something to color with,
- scissors,
- glue,
- and paper.



Instructions:

- Take a toilet paper roll and stand it on its end
- Cut strips of paper and bend about 1/4 inch of each tentacle and glue to the inside of the tube.
- Younger children can count the tentacles (8).
- Slightly older children can count and draw the suckers on each tentacle (4) and the tentacles (8) and then sort out that $4 \times 8 = 32$ either by multiplying or by counting all the suckers.
- Then add a silly face to the octopus
- You can use whatever coloured paper you would like, and can decorate it in any way you choose.
