The Board of Directors is NSBA's decision-making body. Members of the Board are elected from the membership-at-large at each Annual General Meeting. Directors of the association all have voting privileges and the Board is comprised of "Members" (boatbuilders/repairers/boat servicers) and "Associate Members" (suppliers of marine goods and/or services).

The Board of Directors contributes their time and effort to ensure the NSBA continues to work effectively for the benefit of all its members.
